



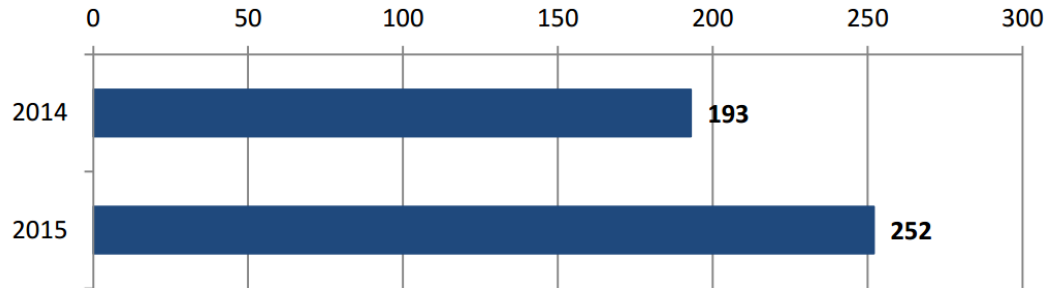

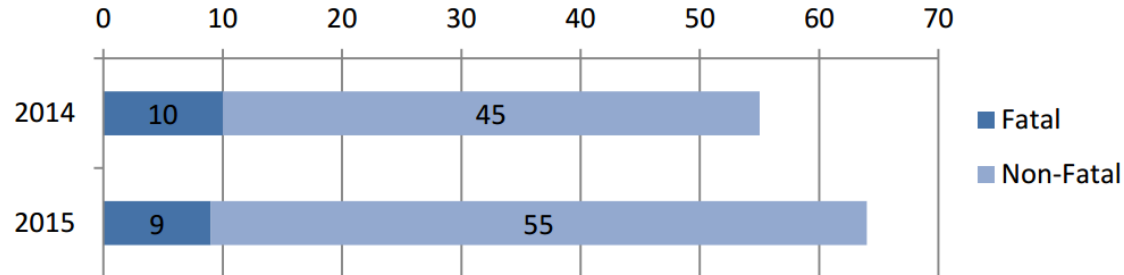


Gun Violence Statistics

January 1 to August 17 (2014 and 2015)

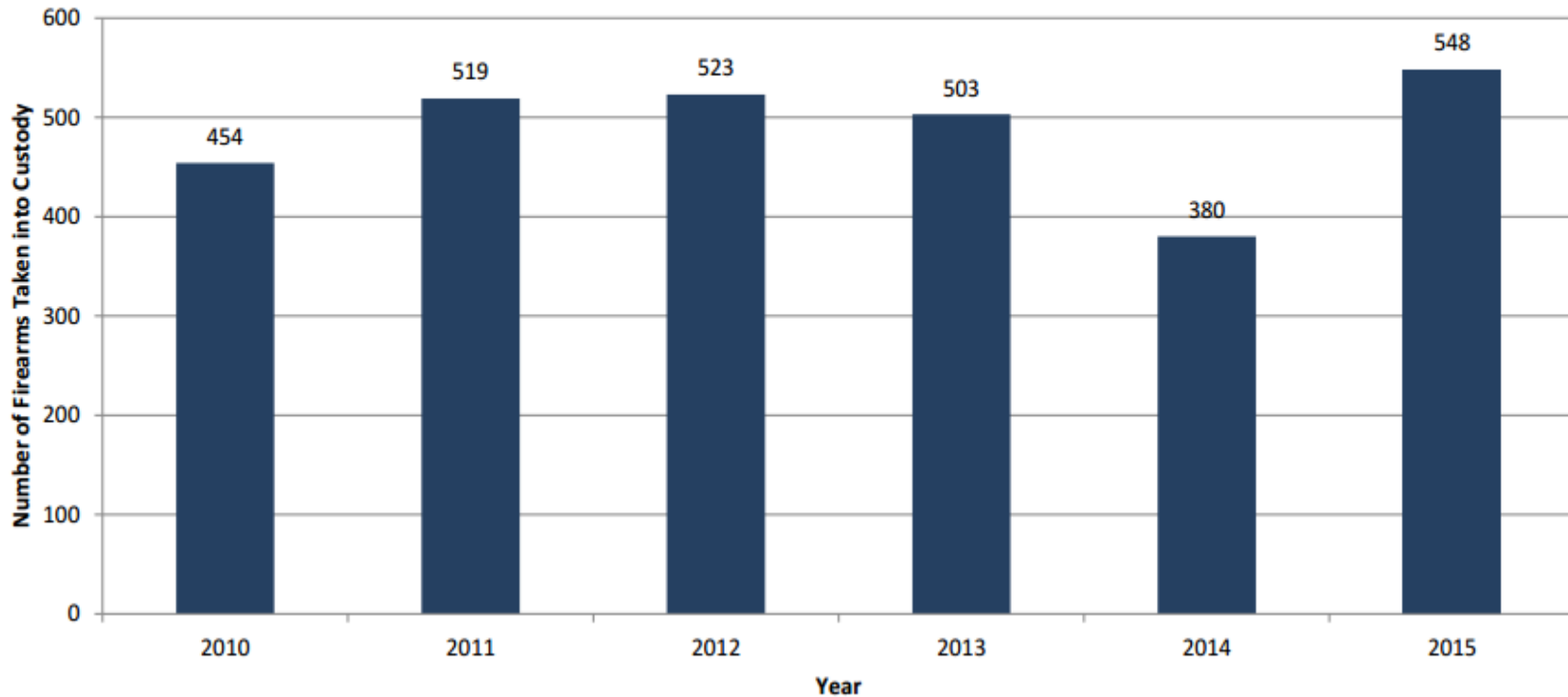




Gun Violence Statistics

Short-Term Tactics

- Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) Daily Analysis
 - Morning briefings
 - Follow-up bulletins
 - Targeted assignments





Short-Term Tactics

- Weekly Violence Crime Meeting
 - Multi-agency meeting
 - SPD Units: Command, Gangs, Intel, ACT, SWAT, Narcotics, MCTF, Precincts, Homicide, Crime Analysts
 - ATF, FBI, US Attorney, KCSO, KCPO, Tukwila, Kent, Federal Way, Renton, Des Moines
 - Goal: Information sharing and swift, effective enforcement assignments



Long Term Strategies

- Gun Crimes Task Force (FBI, ATF) – approximately 130 IBIS/NIBIN hits. ~10 ATF agents and analysts assigned full-time to SPD.
- Executive Steering Committee meeting
- Operation Warrant – 16 Impact players arrested, 14 remain in custody. This list is constantly updated and added to.



Long Term Strategies

- Youth Employment Program
 - Hired 19 young people instead of 5, working with them to produce youth engagement strategy
- Outreach and prevention through community-based initiatives
 - Alive and Free, Boys and Girls Club activities, SHA liaison officers, YMCA
- Harborview Gun Violence
 - Work with Dr. Rivera to reduce victim-to-suspect and re-victimization pipeline

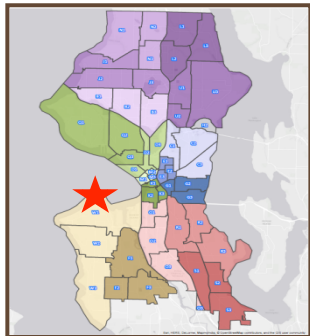

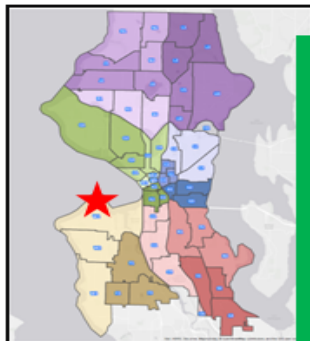

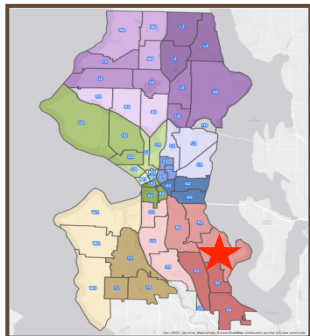
On 08/18/2015, at approx. 2240 hours, S/Tafia approached [redacted] Point, 1146 California Ave. SW. S/Tafia immediately pointed the gun at the victim's head and torso. [redacted] complied. S/Tafia ordered the victim to get away from S/Tafia, S/Tafia fired five shots into their vehicle and S/Tafia got out of the vehicle. The suspect vehicle was [redacted] to him. There were possibly [redacted] followed the suspect [redacted] to police. The suspect [redacted] lost sight of [redacted]. Without [redacted] multiple [redacted] S/Veh [redacted] leg. The suspect who fired at the victim's car and also shot the victim in the leg. S/Tafia for Robbery. If S/Tafia is contacted and arrested in the [redacted] suspect vehicle with a hold for Robbery and have it brought to the processing room. [redacted] contacted inside the suspect vehicle. When S/Tafia is arrested, contact Detective Conrad [redacted] hours. S/Tafia should be considered "ARMED AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS".

As the victim walked away from S/Tafia, S/Tafia fired five shots into their vehicle, which is registered to [redacted] short blond hair that is spiked at the top. There were possibly [redacted] appears to be Hispanic. The victims obtained a plate so they could report the incident to police. The suspect vehicle was [redacted] of 25TH SW and quickly pulled over. The victims did not know the suspects were waiting for them. S/Tafia fired five shots into the victim's car from a 40cal. handgun, striking the victim's right leg. The victim suffered a non-life threatening injury. S/Tafia fired five shots into the victim's car and also shot the victim in the leg. S/Tafia for Robbery. If S/Tafia is contacted and arrested in the suspect vehicle with a hold for Robbery and have it brought to the processing room. [redacted] contacted inside the suspect vehicle. When S/Tafia is arrested, contact Detective Conrad [redacted] hours. S/Tafia should be considered "ARMED AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS".

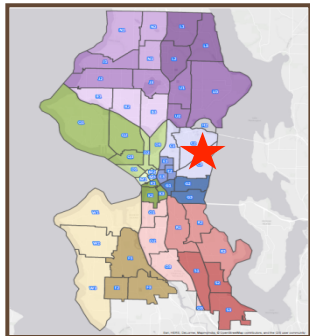
Investigation: - Surveillance indicated MORRIS was dealing drugs and had felony warrant for VUCSA. MORRIS attempted to eluding when contacted.

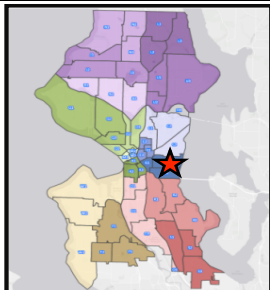

Investigation:

- Lexus associated with the homicide at 26th and E Columbia 15-279100 was located by the victim at 24th and E Fir
- The victim found it because she saw it on You Tube in a rap video in that area
- Officer Chesney was aware of the bulletin when recovering the vehicle. He watched the home made rap video on You Tube and identified suspect as driving the stolen vehicle in the video.
- East ACT and East Patrol went to the suspect's house.
- At the front door Officers were told by his sister that he was not home and had just left.
- Officers thanked the sister and informed her that other officers just caught him climbing out of the back window of her house while they were speaking to her.
- The suspect was arrested for driving the stolen vehicle as evidenced in his published video.

Analytic Judgment: JACKSON appears to be a Deuce 8 associate.

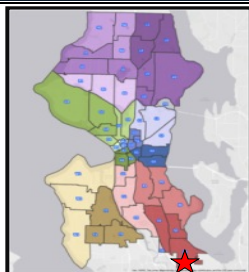
