At approximately 44 hours, I was dispatched to an assault call located at Rainier AV S and S overdale St. The call read: 6 JUV'S ASSAULTING OLDER MALE. J/O. NO WPNS. Y BE HURT.	
vio was V/ kin	on arrival, we were flagged down at Rainier AV S and S Rose St. with our ctim and witness present. I contacted the victim: <b>Second Second</b> . (DOB: ). V/ <b>Second</b> stated that he had been visiting a friend down here and s walking southbound on Rainier AV S. (heading towards the train station). Stated that a group of males had approached him, and asked him what and of phone charger he had in his hand (the victim was carrying a white rtable phone charging device in his hand). V/ <b>Second</b> stated he answered the	2

but then kept walking away. V/ stated that he became aware that the group of 5 males were still following him and watching him closely. V/ stated that he knew at that time, the group were going to attempt to rob him.

V/ stated that one of the males then yelled out to him saying, "hey!" and then came at him, and swung, trying to punch him. V/ ducked twice to avoid the punches, and attempted to swing back and defend himself, but the entire group (5 males) then came towards him and jumped in. stated that he ran into the middle of the street, hoping the males V/wouldn't follow and would scatter - and the males continued to attack striking him multiple times and kicking him. V/ V/stated that the males couldn't acquire any of his property, but all assaulted him. stated that he was not injured- and denied medical assistance, but I V/observed red marks and a few scrapes up and down his left and right arms (on the outside) - V/ stated that was probably from him blocking the strikes from the suspects.

An individual driving on the street pulled up and stopped right as the fight began in the street, observing the entire incident and subjects. This witness stayed until we arrived and was identified as: (DOB: (DOB: ). W/ Stated that he jumped out of his car and yelled at the suspects to stop assaulting the male and to leave him alone. W/

that the group stopped assaulting the male and to leave him alohe. W/ stated that the group stopped assaulting the male and began to scatter. W/ stated that he turned his vehicle around and followed the suspects down the street, where he took a photo of the group of suspect to identify them. W/ shared this photo with Officer LEENSTRA and I when we arrived on scene -and Officer LEENSTRA put the suspect descriptions out over the air.

Other Officers who were in the area searching for the suspects located a group of juveniles matching the description. Officer LEENSTRA and I arrived on scene with them (in the park to the west of the Rainier Beach Community Center). I had the photo of the suspects in my hand as I observed the group of juveniles in front of me. One male perfectly matched the ID of one of the males in the photo; having the same sweat pants, exact same shoes and same build and physical descriptors as one of the suspects in the photo. The only difference was that the male we had detained did not have a jacket (as the suspect did in the photo) - but the jacket in the photo was later observed in his backpack (located during a custodial search, after the suspect was taken into custody). Officer LEENSTRA and I detained the suspect, who identified himself as:

S/**Fine** as one of the suspects involved in the assault. W/**Fine** stated that he observed S/**Fine** as one of the males who ran in and kicked V/**Fine** once he was on the ground.

Officers (and K9) located another one of the suspects described (white male without a shirt and with gray sweat pants) - and got into a foot pursuit with the suspect, ending in a K9 bite/takedown. After being taken into custody, this suspect was also positively identified by W/

).

Both suspects were taken into custody for attempted robbery. The incident and arrests were screened by SGT DUNCKLE #7509.

S/ was brought to SPD Headquarters to be photographed and fingerprinted (per SPD Policy). Afterwards, he was booked into YSC. Second was sent to YSC with his backpack that was on him - filled with miscellaneous possessions as well as his wallet and phone. Officer LEENSTRA contacted S/ s mother and notified her of the arrest and booking into YSC. S/ clothing (which was how he was identified) was placed into evidence.

I spoke with an SPD Officer who was working off duty at the Rainier Beach Community Center (he frequently works there). I showed Officer FIELDS #5036 a photo of the suspects, and he immediately pointed to one suspect (the main one wearing a do-rag on his head) and stated that he believed the male suspect to ", a 16-year old juvenile who frequents the Community Center. be " Officer FIELDS also called me later; (while I was at headquarters) and stated that a Rainier Beach Community Center employee: " pulled up the surveillance video for the community center - and that the 3 missing suspects from the incident were observed walking into the community center today, and some had changed their clothes. On the video, the suspect wearing gray shorts with the backpack walked into the center at approximately 1953 hours for a moment and then walked out. " " who was identified had walked into the center at approximately 1954 hours - in a gray hooded sweatshirt/jacket, and had a white emblem on his pants. The last suspect (tall subject) was observed as having what appeared to be a blonde streak on the top of his hair (curly) - and had changed into shorts, but was holding his jeans in his hands. Officer FIELDS stated that the footage typically takes about a week to retrieve from their IT company - but that if needed, Officers/Detectives can contact Tiffany Jordan at the center for further contact.

Officer LEENSTRA and I brought the booking form for Second up to Harborview Medical Center; where Sector was being treated for his dog-bite injuries. While I was there, S/ stated that he would provide a recorded statement about the incident and his involvement. See stated that he was part of the group, and was just sitting by V/ (who they didn't know). See stated was trying to sell his phone charger, and had offered to those that V/ around him, the chance to buy it. See stated that one of the members of his group did not like the way Variant was looking at him, and thought it was "disrespectful". S/ stated that he at one point heard V/ say something towards the group, but didn't hear anything. See stated that he wasn't sure if anyone else in the group heard him say anything, because members of the group were looking at each other and making statements to the effect of, "what did he say?" S/ stated that there were no threats made, no assault, and no weapons observed. S/ stated that after the one male in the group was offended, the group began following Variants. S/market stated that by that point, the group had already "decided to do what they did".

Second stated that Version had gotten pretty far ahead, so they began jogging to catch up to him - and got within 15 feet of him, and then one of the

guys started "swinging" on V/ . S/ stated that the fight then spilled into the street, and the other guys jumped in and began assaulting V/ as well. See stated that towards the end of the incident, he too joined in, but only threw one kick at V/ foot made contact with V . . So described the incident as being one of those situations where "if your brother swings, you swing", and that he felt the peer pressure to join in. S/ stated that he knew it was wrong, and that it wasn't anything he would ever do on his own, but feared what could happen if he didn't join in (fear of looking like a "pussy", or retaliation from the group, later on). named multiple people in the group; providing me with first names only of: ". Officers recognized one of the names, " as that of a juvenile male who lives in the area: " ). " was identified by Officer FIELDS as " (DOB: (unknown DOB) - I was unable to locate any history for RMS, but that is the name he signs into the community center under. was booked into YSC, and transported there by AMR. Second ' clothing (which was how he was identified) was placed into evidence. S/ was also sent to YSC with him, as well as his cellphone. Officers attempted to call V/ back to get a statement and photos from him, but when we called the number provided by V/ answered stated that they were not V/, and did not know him.
