I believe:

I am a victim of stalking.

- repeatedly contacting the victim or attempting to contact or monitor the victim for no lawful purpose and his/her actions caused the victim to feel intimidated, frightened, or threatened.

The respondent's actions toward the victim have seriously alarmed, annoyed, or harassed the victim, or are detrimental to the victim and serve no legitimate or lawful purpose. The respondent's actions have caused substantial emotional distress to the victim or caused me to fear for the well-being of my child.

The respondent has committed acts of harassment or stalking as follows:

A. Describe the most recent incident of harassment or stalking.

Date and time (on or around): On 1/18/2021 on or around 2pm-5pm

Location: Petitioner's personal residence in Seattle, WA, King County.

What did the respondent do or say that you believe to be harassing or stalking behavior?

On 1/18/21, respondent, who has visited my home at least six times, was in front of my personal residence alone and confronted me as I pulled out of my driveway by yelling at me and trying to engage me. I could not hear all of what she said, except a few obscenities. I recognized her because as noted before she had previously confronted me outside my home on Christmas Eve, screaming obscenities and death threats.

As I returned home, my son was in my car and she temporarily blocked the driveway to my home. Because of other threats I have received, Seattle Police Officers had been near my residence and were talking with her. She yelled some things at me, and still appeared somewhat agitated. Officers informed her that I did not wish to have contact with her. She would not leave and remained in front of my home for several hours. She was acting erratically -- sitting and standing in the street staring at the house, walking in my drive, and taking pictures of the house. After hours of doing this, she threw an objects into my yard then left.

While there, she posted a photos of my home on social media and urged others to come "crash" my home because I was there. These posts were then removed as a violation of Twitter policy, for doxxing.

Two Seattle Police Department Officers who were present filed an incident report 2021-14692. There is also video footage of of some portions of this incident available for review.

B. Describe other incidents of harassment or stalking. For each incident, include the date, time (on or about), location, what was said, how statements were made, and what was done to a victim.

The Respondent has shown up at my house on multiple occasions exhibiting threatening verbal and physical behavior. As Mayor of Seattle, I am assigned officers from the Seattle Police Department's Executive Protection Unit ("EPU"). Over multiple incidents, the confrontations by Respondent towards me and the EPU have escalated. The Respondent lives near my house (approx 2 mins in drive time or 10-12 mins walk) and has harassed and stalked me at my home as recently as 1/18 and on the following known previous occasions:

10/31/2020 - On Halloween night, Respondent showed up at my residence dressed in a helmet, knee pads and all dark clothes. She was by herself at the time. EPU approached her and she asked them if they had seen anyone else dressed like her. EPU believed she was under the impression that there was to be some sort of gathering. She stood in front of my house for a few hours in the pouring rain staring at the house.

12/14/2020 - Respondent again came to my home and spent time in the neighborhood. She posted signs throughout neighborhood and at my house.

12/24/2020 - On Christmas Eve on or about 6pm, I came out of my house to give cookies to EPU. Respondent unexpectedly jumped out from a bush about 20-25 ft away and screamed at the top of her lungs "Merry Christmas, you fucking bitch!" She continued to scream a string of obscenities and death threats. It was a very prolonged, screaming rant. She also screamed "I will be back and I am not going away!" Respondent would not leave and stayed for approximately 2.5 hrs, staring at the house, muttering and yelling things, and acting quite erratically. SPD were present, and while she engaged briefly with them, their presence did not deter her or cause her to leave.

1/6/2021 - Respondent was posting signs on my fence and standing in the street. Two neighbors were taking down the signs.

In addition to the above in-person incidents, in publicly available media the Respondent acknowledged she has mental health issues and those issues led her to commit a crime (a bank robbery). She seems fixated on me and seeking attention. I have received death threats as a result of my tenure as U.S. Attorney, so my address is protected under the state address confidentiality program, but Respondent has made social media posts containing pictures of my house and its location.

6. How did the incidents you describe above make you, the minor, or the vulnerable adult feel?

Respondent's activities are alarming, appear to be escalating and her aggressive and her erratic behavior, compounded by her self-admitted mental illness are concerning. Since August, Respondent has been arrested at least six times, she also has an arrest for bank robbery. She is persistent, both in person and online, and her actions continue to escalate. Her repeated, in-person aggression and unpredictable acts, and her attempts to seek attention give me direct and immediate concerns that she presents a real danger to me and my family.


An emergency exists as described below. I request that a **Temporary Protection Order** granting the relief I requested above for a no-contact, surveillance, exclude from places, or stay away order be issued immediately, without prior notice to the respondent, be effective until the hearing.

I also request a temporary surrender and prohibition of all firearms, other dangerous weapons, and concealed pistol licenses without notice to the other party because irreparable injury could result if an order is not issued until the hearing.

What irreparable harm would result if an order is not issued immediately without prior notice to the respondent?
