Good evening,

I want to give you a run-down of what happened – please know this is preliminary information and subject to change as the investigation moves forward.

At about 6 o'clock tonight - just outside the Seattle Center Armory - at least two people opened fire.

It appears these individuals were aiming at each other but in the end seven people attending the Bite of Seattle were struck by bullets.

I am so grateful that SPD officers were on-scene working at the event because they were able to jump in immediately to perform lifesaving measures to stop the violence and treat injured victims.

Three people lost their lives in this tragic violence. Two died at the scene and another passed away at Harborview Medical Center.

We have an additional four people at Harborview Medical Center and one at UW Medical Center main campus. All are in stable condition.

It pains me to say that one of our victims is a two-year-old child. That child is thankfully listed in stable condition.

Again, this is an active and ongoing investigation. We have dozens of officers and detectives across Seattle Center processing the scene.

We are questioning a person of interest. We believe he was one of the two people firing rounds. He is currently with detectives at a police facility.

We will be posting additional information on The Blotter as information develops. We have an SPD employee monitoring the Violent Crimes Tip Line tonight. That phone number is 206-233-5000
